ARTICLE 3

Shall the voters approve the following amendment to the Washington Central Unified Union School District Articles of Agreement:

Article 15 (tentative) – Input on Policy and Budget Development

The District Board shall provide timely and sufficient opportunity for local input on policy and budget development; structures to support and encourage public participation within the District will be established by the District Board of School Directors on or before June 30, 2020.

These structures may include but not be limited to local school councils that have an advisory responsibility in key areas.

ARTICLE 4

Shall the voters approve the following amendment to the Washington Central Unified Union School District Articles of Agreement:

Article 16 (tentative)

If a competent judicial authority concludes that any of these articles are illegal for any reason, then that article or part thereof shall be nullified. The remaining article or part thereof shall be deemed severable from the nullified article or section of an article and shall remain in full force and effect.
