1. Administrative Operations
  - a. Eric moved to approve July minutes, Dave seconded. Approved

2. Correspondence. Vermont Trails and Greenways Newsletter. Next Central Vermont Forest Stewardship meeting will be held on 9/25 at the CVRPC offices in Montpelier.
3. Project Reports
  - a. Wrightsville Update: possible work project to anchor one of the foot bridges. Eric suggested some drainage work would be helpful to carry water away from the trail.
  - b. Middlesex Village enhancement grant. Approved signage for village entries. No time line for installation.
4. Three Mile Bridge Road FEMA Buyout Parcel. Brainstorming of how use and access the parcel in the future after it is cleaned up.
5. Town Forest update: Town Forest Stewardship Subcommittee
  - a. Villeneuve Property access agreement: Final draft of the agreement is in the hand of the forester for review. Dave suggested we check in with the Select Board and with the county forester about marking trees for harvesting in the town forest.
  - b. Boundary Marking: Bill Rossmassler has a call into the surveyor to coordinate a walk and better marking of boundaries. Hope to do this the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of October.
  - c. Hoyt parcel: taking up review at the next LARC (land acquisition review committee) meeting.
  - d. Trail scouting and flagging: look into possible grant funding sources for trail development. Possible trail work day, October 6<sup>th</sup>. Dave to schedule and see if folks are available.
