 - ii. Public meeting may be planned for the summer.
 - b. Wrightsville Recreation Area:
 - i. Colin O'Neil attended the March MCC meeting. He submitted two grants: 1) Health and Education Grant to set up a fitness / recreation plan with signage and information material. Classes for Yoga, fitness, bike, fishing, canoeing. Wrightsville is open May 1 through Columbus Day.
 - c. Conservation Fund: Dave suggested that the Conservation Fund guidance document be revised concerning fund project approval.
 - d. The Select board will warn the \$5,000 appropriation for the Conservation Fund for the upcoming town meeting vote
 - e. Middlesex Village- no new news on the Scenic Byway / Enhancement Grant
