Middlesex Select Board Minutes September 25, 2012

Meeting called to order at 5:30 pm

Dan Currier, Central VT Regional Planning Commission, discusses the Class 3 and Class 4 Road Erosion inventory program. The “problem” sites are located and prioritized. Once they are prioritized the Regional Planning Commission will present possible solutions to the sites. The Regional Planning Commission has partnered with Better Back Roads. A report will be presented to the Town once it is completed along with maps. Better Back Roads has grants available for these types of road improvements. It is expected that a draft report will be completed in early October, with a final report presented before the end of the year.

Angelo Napolitano updates the Board on his conversations concerning speed enforcement in the Village. Angelo has been advised that the State Police Department does not have any available troopers as promised at the meeting with Agency of Transportation. Angelo is working with Lt. Flanagan to receive a speed cart. The cart has radar capabilities. The data will then be reviewed to determine the speed of traffic through the village.

Angelo discusses the application from the State of Vermont to construct a temporary housing unit on State property. The Board reports that the State of Vermont did a presentation at the last Select Board meeting outlining the proposed facility. The State was asked to do a press release so residents in the community are aware of the proposal.

The list of the 2011 delinquent taxes was reviewed.

Correspondence

A notice from Official Payments, the company that accepted credit card payment for property taxes, that they are implementing an annual network access fee in the amount of \$1,000 due to the premium volume on the account. We have asked if this could be looked at and reduced.

Notice from FEMA that the proposed modified flood elevation determinations will be approved as the final Flood Insurance Rate map.

Other Business

The Board discusses the invoice from the fire department for supplies for the open house. The Board agrees to require the fire department to pay the bill from their funds. All orders are signed with the adjustment to the fire department invoice.
