Old Business

Enhanced Energy Plan

The pathways to implementation section of the EEP calls for the creation of an Energy Committee as well as appointment of an Energy Coordinator. Lauri Scharf has expressed interest in serving in this role and has been invited to this meeting to discuss.

Sandy shared a timeline we'd have to keep in mind in order to meet our goal of having the EEP ready for a vote by the November elections. The schedule is fairly tight, but appears achievable. In order to keep

this task on schedule, members are asked to get any suggested edits to Theo [prior to the April 15 meeting by May 1](#).

Lauri offered his feedback that likes the initial draft plan. He feels the plan has an appropriate amount of detail, while also including a fairly broad scope.

Lauri asked if the EEP would [be](#) a main focus of the PC between now and November. Seeing the EEP through to adoption (hopefully in November) is a goal of the PC, but it's not anticipated to be the main focus of the PC. The PC hopes to have the Energy Committee and Energy Coordinator take the lead on finalizing the draft, community engagement, and making revisions to the draft plan based on feedback from the community.

Lauri will reach out to others he knows who may have an interest in serving on the Energy Committee. We will try to get an Energy Committee put together in next few weeks, with hopes they can help with finalizing the draft EEP.
